NEW MEXICO - PARTLY CLOUDY WITH SCATTERED AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS EXCEPT NORTHWEST CORNER. HIGHS 70'S TO 80'S MOUNTAINS AND NORTHEAST WITH 80'S AND 90'S WEST AND SOUTH. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 10 PERCENT NORTHWEST CORNER TO 30 PERCENT THUNDERSTORM AREAS. WINDS VARIABLE 5-15 MPH NORTH. ANALYSIS: FIRE ACTIVITY HAS INCREASED IN ALASKA AND THE SOUTHWEST.

INCIDENTAL OVERHEAD ORDERS CONTINUE FOR ALASKA. ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR SMOKEJUMPERS HAVE BEEN SENT TO ALASKA.

PROGNOSIS: ORDERS FROM ALASKA TO THE LOWER 48 EXPECTED TO CONTINUE. RESOURCES REMAIN ADEQUATE.

COLORADO - SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS MAINLY CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN MOUNTAINS AND EASTERN PLAINS. MOSTLY CLEAR SKIES AND HOT WEST. HIGHS 70'S AND 80'S MOUNTAINS AND EAST TO MID 90'S LOWER WESTERN VALLEYS. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 35-45 PERCENT CENTRAL MOUNTAINS AND SOUTHEAST TO 20-30 PERCENT WESTERN MOUNTAINS AND NORTHEAST TO 8-15 PERCENT SOUTHWEST CORNER AND WEST CENTRAL VALLEYS. WINDS LIGHT EXCEPT LOCALLY STRONG AND GUSTY NEAR THUNDERSTORMS.

ARIZONA - PARTLY CLOUDY MOUNTAINS AND EAST WITH SOME AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS EAST CENTRAL AND SOUTHEAST. MOSTLY SUNNY ELSEWHERE. CONTINUED HOT. HIGHS 80'S AND LOW 90'S MOUNTAINS TO 107-113 LOWER WESTERN DESERTS. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 8-25 PERCENT DESERTS AND 35 PERCENT EAST CENTRAL MOUNTAINS. LOCAL AFTERNOON BREEZES EXCEPT STRONGER AND GUSTY WINDS NEAR THUNDERSTORMS.

NEW MEXICO - PARTLY CLOUDY WITH SCATTERED AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS MOSTLY CENTRAL MOUNTAINS AND EAST. HIGHS 70'S TO MID 80'S MOUNTAINS AND NORTHEAST WITH MID 80'S TO MID 90'S WEST AND SOUTH. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 15 PERCENT NORTHWEST TO 35 PERCENT SOUTHEAST. WINDS VARIABLE 5-20 MPH EXCEPT STRONGER AND GUSTY NEAR THUNDERSTORMS.

ANALYSIS: NEW FIRE STARTS ARE CONTINUING IN ALASKA WITH MAJOR ACREAGE INCREASES ON SOME FIRES. AN ADDITIONAL AIRTANKER HAS BEEN SENT TO ALASKA AS WELL AS MISCELLANEOUS OVERHEAD AND SUPPLIES.

PROGNOSIS: CONTINUED ACTIVITY EXPECTED IN ALASKA, HOWEVER COOLER TEMPERATURES AND HIGHER HUMIDITIES SHOULD AID IN SUPPRESSION EFFORTS. POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR INCREASED HUMAN CAUSED FIRES THROUGHOUT THE U.S. WITH THE UP COMING 4TH OF JULY WEEKEND. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES ARE EXPECTED.

THE MAJORITY OF THE THUNDERSTORMS BEING TOUCHED OFF BY THIS MOISTURE CONTAIN SOME RAIN, WITH THE DRIER ONES CONCENTRATING OVER SOUTHERN MONTANA. HIGHS ARE RUNNING IN THE 90'S WITH LOW 100'S IN THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA DESERTS. COOLER WEST OF THE CASCADES WITH HIGHS IN THE 80'S. COASTAL AREAS SHOULD ONLY BE IN THE 60'S AND 70'S.

ANALYSIS: CALIFORNIA AND NEVADA IS EXPERIENCING INCREASED INITIAL ATTACK ACTIVITY. ONLY A COUPLE LARGE FIRES ARE CURRENTLY BURNING IN THE LOWER 48 STATES.

PROGNOSIS: EXPECT FIRE ACTIVITY TO INCREASE WITH PREDICTED THUNDERSTORMS AND HOLDOVER FIRES BEING DISCOVERED. POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR MULTIPLE LARGE FIRE ACTIVITY. RESOURCES CONTINUE TO BE ADEQUATE.
