FIRE WEATHER - SOUTHERN U.S.

RAINY OVER THE SOUTHEAST TODAY AND TONIGHT EXCEPT FOR SOUTHERN FLORIDA. HIGHS 40S NORTH TO 60S SOUTH. LOWS FROM THE LOWER 20S AND 30S NORTH TO 50S SOUTH. SATURDAY, COLDER MAINLY NORTH WITH A CHANCE OF RAIN. SUNDAY, MOSTLY CLOUDY WITH CHANCE OF SNOW IN THE NORTH AND RAIN TO THE SOUTH. MONDAY AND TUESDAY, CLEARING THROUGH ARKANSAS, TENNESSEE AND GEORGIA. GULF COASTAL STATES, CLOUDY WITH A CHANCE OF RAIN.

FIRE ACTIVITY: 80 FIRES FOR 3063 ACRES WERE REPORTED THIS WEEK.

ANALYSIS: LOW TO MODERATE FIRE DANGER PREDOMINATES THE SOUTHERN, WITH MODERATE TO EXTREME CONDITIONS EXISTING IN ISOLATED LOCATIONS.

PROGNOSIS: MINIMAL FIRE ACTIVITY EXPECTED THROUGH THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE U.S.

A COLD FRONT WILL EXIT SOUTHERN FLORIDA FRIDAY, RESULTING IN DRY, BUT COLD AND WINDY WEATHER OVER THE AREA. HIGH PRESSURE WILL MOVE FROM THE MISSISSIPPI VALLEY SATURDAY INTO THE CAROLINAS SUNDAY. A NEW STORM WILL DEVELOP OVER TEXAS ON SUNDAY. RAIN WITH THIS STORM WILL SPREAD FROM TEXAS TO THE SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI VALLEY INTO FLORIDA MONDAY AND TUESDAY. THE OUTLOOK FOR WEDNESDAY THE 16TH THROUGH SATURDAY THE 19TH CALLS FOR ABOVE NORMAL PRECIPITATION AND NEAR TO BELOW NORMAL TEMPERATURES, EXCEPT SOUTHERN FLORIDA WITH ABOVE NORMAL TEMPERATURES.

FIRE ACTIVITY: 187 FIRES FOR 2031 ACRES WERE REPORTED THIS WEEK.

ANALYSIS: LOW TO MODERATE FIRE DANGER PREDOMINATES THE SOUTHERN AREA, WITH UNITS IN SOUTH FLORIDA REPORTING MODERATE TO HIGH.

FAIR TODAY EXCEPT A FEW SHOWERS IN SOUTHERN FLORIDA. FRONTAL SYSTEM WITH RAIN IN TEXAS SATURDAY MOVING TO THE CAROLINAS AND SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI VALLEY SUNDAY AND INTO FLORIDA ON MONDAY. HIGHS 50'S AND 60'S WITH 70'S TO LOW 80'S SOUTHERN FLORIDA. THE OUTLOOK FOR WEDNESDAY THE 23RD THROUGH SATURDAY THE 26TH CALLS FOR NEAR NORMAL TEMPERATURES EXCEPT ABOVE NORMAL FLORIDA AND BELOW NORMAL FROM NORTHERN ALABAMA TO THE CAROLINAS. PRECIPITATION WILL BE NEAR NORMAL EXCEPT DRIER THAN NORMAL FLORIDA AND WETTER THAN NORMAL OVER THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER VALLEY.

FIRE ACTIVITY: 61 FIRES FOR 1,389 ACRES WERE REPORTED THIS WEEK.

ANALYSIS: LOW TO MODERATE FIRE DANGER PREDOMINATES THE SOUTHERN AREA EXCEPT FOR HIGH INDICES IN FLORIDA NATIONAL PARKS.

PROGNOSIS: POTENTIAL FOR FIRE ACTIVITY CONTINUES IN FLORIDA WITH FORECASTED ABOVE NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND DRIER THAN NORMAL CONDITIONS.

THE TAIL END OF A COLD FRONT WITH RAIN IS MOVING INTO THE SOUTH ATLANTIC STATES TODAY WITH COLD AIR SPREADING IN BEHIND THE FRONT. A DRY HIGH PRESSURE SYSTEM WILL SETTLE IN OVER THE SOUTHEAST AND PERSIST INTO MONDAY. HIGHS WILL BE IN THE 40'S AND 50'S WITH 60'S AND 70'S OVER FLORIDA. HIGHS IN THE 30'S AND 40'S EXCEPT 50' S AND 60'S ALONG THE GULF AND SOUTHERN ATLANTIC COASTS OVER THE WEEKEND. THE OUTLOOK FOR TUESDAY THE 29TH THROUGH SATURDAY JANUARY 2ND CALLS FOR NEAR NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND PRECIPITATION EXCEPT FOR BELOW NORMAL TEMPERATURES WITH ABOVE NORMAL PRECIPITATION OVER THE SEABOARD OF THE CAROLINAS AND VIRGINIA.
