NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

Current Situation: Initial attack activity remained low. Large fire activity was minimal, except the Oak Hill fire in California.

Eastern Great Basin Area Large Fires:

THUNDERBOLT, Boise NF. Helicopter water drops and crews working hot spots continued.

CORRAL CREEK/BLACKWELL COMPLEX, Payette NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Lee) is assigned. No significant changes reported.

CHICKEN COMPLEX, Payette NF. Plans are to demob the ICP today.

California - South Zone Large Fires:

OAK HILL, Santa Barbara County, California State. The fire continues to threaten the high value residential communities of Vandenberg, Mission Hills and Mesa Oaks. Oil and gas facilities including buildings and lines are also at risk. Potential for erratic fire behavior remains high due to shifting winds approaching 25 MPH.

Outlook: A weak low pressure system passing through the northern states will bring clouds and lower temperatures. Montana and northern Idaho will have scattered showers. The remainder of the northern half of the West will be partly cloudy while the southern half will be mostly sunny. Temperatures will be 4-8 degrees cooler and humidities will be slightly higher in most areas. The Sierra and Cascade mountains will have gusty southwest or west winds 15-25 MPH. Fire activity is expected to be low, with the exception of southern California which has the potential for continued activity.
