MAUD, Arizona State - 1,000 acres. The fire started on S/2 and was contained the same day.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN: No activity.

ANALYSIS: The Southwest and Southern Areas continued to experience increased initial attack activity.

PROGNOSIS: High pressure over Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, Florida and the Carolina's will result in warm and dry weather through the coming week. Expect initial attack activity to continue in the Southern Area. An upper level low pressure system will move into southern California and the Southwest Area this weekend. Showers will increase with cooler temperatures over the entire area through most of next week. Minimal activity is anticipated in the Southwest and southern California.

ANALYSIS: Increased activity was experienced in the Southern and Eastern Areas. Numerous units are reporting high to extreme indices throughout the Southern Area. The Mark Twain NF and Missouri State in the Eastern Area also reported extreme indices. Internal mobilization continued with minimal support from other Areas.

PROGNOSIS: Scattered showers and thundershowers will dominate the southwest Friday through the weekend. Fair weather and drying will occur during the first part of next week before more precipitation at the end of the week. Fire activity in the southwestern states will be minimal. Low pressure will move through the Southern Area bringing scattered showers. Drying will occur through the rest of the week; but remaining wet along the eastern seaboard. Temperatures will run below normal. Drying conditions behind the weather front will lead to slight increases in fire activity in the Southern Area.
