

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY, JULY 7, 1995 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** THE TEN STANDARD FIRE ORDERS ARE FIRM ***
*** WE DON'T BREAK THEM; WE DON'T BEND THEM ***

Current Situation: Increased initial attack activity occurred in the northern half of the western U.S. due to lightning activity. Twenty Sustained Action Squads will be demobilized from Canada to the Northern Rockies, Great Basin and Northwest today. Large fire activity continued in Canada with 79,618 additional acres burned.

Outlook: A FIRE WEATHER WATCH is posted for the eastern half of Arizona for dry lightning. A strong ridge of high pressure will cover most of the west from the central and southern Rockies to California. A low pressure system off the Washington and Oregon coasts will send surges of moisture into the Pacific Northwest and the Northern Rockies. Scattered showers and thundershowers are forecast for Washington, Oregon, Idaho and Montana. Isolated dry thunderstorms are forecast in Utah, eastern Arizona and New Mexico. Highs for the western U.S. will be in the 80's and 90's, while the southwest deserts will be 100-115 degrees. Increased initial attack activity is anticipated with forecasted thunderstorms.

NEW FIRE WEATHER DEFINITIONS

To avoid the overuse of RED FLAG terminology, the National Weather Service has replaced Red Flag Watch with FIRE WEATHER WATCH.

FIRE WEATHER WATCH: A POSSIBLE critical fire weather pattern.

RED FLAG WARNING: An ONGOING or IMMINENT critical fire weather pattern.
