**Current Situation:** The Southern Area continued to experience initial attack activity. The Northern Rockies, particularly eastern Montana experienced an increase in initial attack and large fire activity.

**Outlook -** A westerly flow aloft will bring normal to slightly above normal temperatures to the Southern Area, with a chance of rain through Thursday. The southern Appalachian mountains can expect rain mixed with snow.

**Current Situation:** Initial attack activity continued at a moderate pace in the Southern, Eastern and Southwest Areas.

**Outlook - Southern Area:** Surface low pressure will ride across the northern Gulf of Mexico through Friday, resulting in showers and thunderstorms along the Gulf Coast states through Saturday. Elsewhere, surface high pressure and generally dry weather will hold until Monday. A cold front will approach the Gulf Coast and the Tennessee Valley on Tuesday bringing a chance of showers and thunderstorms. Highs will range from the 50's and 60's across Tennessee and North Carolina to 70's and 80's on the Gulf Coast and Florida. **Eastern Area:** A surface cold front will slowly drop south into the Area through Tuesday with intermittent showers. Highs will be in the middle 30's and 40's in the north, with 50's and 60's in the south.
