

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2001- 0530 MDT  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationwide. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Colorado, Nevada, Utah and Texas.

EASTERN AREA SUPPORT:

DUANE STREET SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Stam) is assigned. The team will continue to provide planning support at the Duane Street Fire Station and logistics support to manage warehouse operations at Pier 36.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

70, Butte Unit, California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection. A CDF Type 1 Incident Management Team (Stovall) is assigned. This fire is 25 miles north of Oroville, CA. Highway 70 is closed at Big Bend. Other road closures also remain in effect.

OUTLOOK:

\*\*\* A RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN ISSUED IN WESTERN VIRGINIA, NORTHWEST NORTH CAROLINA AND WESTERN SOUTH CAROLINA FOR LOW MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND STRONG, GUSTY WINDS \*\*\*

High pressure aloft over the Northern California Area is bringing lighter winds and warm, dry conditions. Conditions will remain mostly sunny, with temperatures in the low 60s to low 80s inland. Relative humidity will range from 10-20%, driest inland. Winds will be mostly north to east at 8 to 12 mph.

A cold front is ushering in a dry and windy airmass to the Mid-Atlantic States. Winds will remain strong through the early evening hours, especially at higher elevations. Temperatures will be in the lower 40s in the mountains and upper 50s in the Carolina Piedmont with minimum relative humidity ranging in the upper teens to mid 20s. Along the Appalachians and southeastward through the Carolina Piedmont, winds will range from 20 to

35 mph.

In the Great Basin Area, weather conditions will remain dry. Temperatures will be in the 60s across northern Nevada and Utah, to the lower 80s in southern Nevada. Minimum relative humidity will range from the mid teens across southern Nevada, to the mid 20 to 40 percent range in the northern portion of the region. Winds will be light and variable.

High pressure continues to dominate southwest Texas. Temperatures will be in the mid 60s in the higher elevations to upper 80s along the Rio Grande. Minimum relative humidity will be in the upper teens to 25 percent with winds light and variable.
