**Sesnon**, Los Angeles County FD. Unified command between Cal Fire IMT 1 (Hodson), Ventura County FD, Los Angeles County FD and Los Angeles City FD. Seven miles northeast of Simi Valley, CA. Chaparral. Wind-driven fire behavior with long-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Marek**, Angeles NF. Unified command between IMT 1 (Opliger), Los Angeles County FD and Los Angeles City FD. Five miles east of San Fernando, CA. Chaparral. Active fire behavior. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Juliatt**, Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base. IMT 2 (Fiorella). Nine miles northeast of Oceanside, CA. Chaparral and grass. Active fire behavior. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Chalk**, Los Padres NF. Nine miles north of Gorda, CA. Chaparral. Increased fire activity.
