HIGHLIGHTS

AK - NO ACTIVITY.

NW - PRYOR, WILLAMETTE NF - 766 ACRES. TYPE II TEAM (LINDSEY) COMMITTED. STEEP, ROCKY TERRAIN, LIMITED ACCESS AND POISON OAK CONTINUE TO HAMPER CONTROL EFFORTS. THE FIRE IS 80% CONTAINED WITH FULL CONTAINMENT EXPECTED 9/2.

LUDI 2, LAKEVIEW DISTRICT BLM - 1,020 ACRES. FIRE IS STILL BURNING IN THE LAVA FIELD AND IS BEING MONITORED. NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT.

CA - NORTH ZONE - INITIAL ATTACK ACTIVITY.

SOUTH ZONE - PIUTE, CALIFORNIA DESERT DISTRICT, BLM - 680+ ACRES. FIRE IS BURNING IN STEEP, ROCKY, INACCESSIBLE TERRAIN APPROXIMATELY 7 MILES NORTH OF THE CALNEVARI PIUTE RANGE. CONTAINMENT WAS EXPECTED LAST NIGHT.

NR - PORCUPINE COMPLEX, NEZ PERCE NF - 28,170 ACRES. TYPE I TEAM (BAILEY) COMMITTED. STRUCTURE PROTECTION GROUPS REMAIN IN PLACE TO PROTECT RANCHES ALONG THE SALMON RIVER. BURNOUT OPERATIONS YESTERDAY WEST OF BEMIS RANCH WERE SUCCESSFUL. THE FIRE IS 60% CONTAINED WITH FULL CONTAINMENT EXPECTED THIS EVENING, 9/1.

GB - IDAHO - NO SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY.

INTERMOUNTAIN - FOOTHILLS, BOISE NF/BOISE DISTRICT, BLM - 257,600 ACRES. AN AREA COMMAND IS IN PLACE (SMITH) . THE FIRE IS DIVIDED INTO THREE ZONES WITH INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAMS IN PLACE: TYPE I TEAM (MANN) NORTH ZONE, TYPE I TEAM (RICHER) SOUTH ZONE AND TYPE II TEAM (CASEY) BLM ZONE. LINE CONSTRUCTION AND MOP-UP OPERATIONS ARE CONTINUING. FIVE MILES OF LINE REMAIN OPEN. THE FIRE IS 95% CONTAINED WITH FULL CONTAINMENT EXPECTED 9/6.

TOMATO POINT, PAYETTE NF - 2,400 ACRES. TYPE I TEAM (MADDEN) COMMITTED. FIRE IS BURNING IN STEEP, RUGGED COUNTRY ACROSS THE SALMON RIVER FROM THE PORCUPINE INCIDENT. NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT.

NEVADA - DAWLEY CREEK, HUMBOLDT NF - 2,400 ACRES. THE FIRE IS 60% CONTAINED WITH FULL CONTAINMENT EXPECTED TODAY, 9/1.

UTAH - POLE CANYON, SALT LAKE CITY DISTRICT, BLM - 450 ACRES. TYPE II TEAM (BARBER) COMMITTED. STEEP TERRAIN AND LIMITED ACCESS ARE HAMPERING CONTAINMENT EFFORTS. THE FIRE IS 85% CONTAINED WITH FULL CONTAINMENT EXPECTED THIS EVENING, 9/1.

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE - ALL RISK INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM (GALE) COMMITTED. THE TEAM IS WORKING FOR THE SUPERINTENDENTS OF EVERGLADES, BISCAYNE AND BIG CYPRESS NATIONAL PARKS. THE TEAMS MISSION CONSISTS OF EMPLOYEE WELL BEING, SECURING THE FACILITIES, RESTORING COMMUNICATIONS AND POWER, DETERMINING ASSISTANCE NEEDED IN ORDER TO OPEN THE PARKS FOR THE VISITOR SEASON, AND DETERMINING ASSISTANCE NEEDED TO FULLY RESTORE ALL FACILITIES.

FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY - TYPE I TEAM (DENTON) COMMITTED TO MANAGE A MOBILIZATION CENTER AT FRANKLIN, LOUISIANA. TYPE II TEAM (COATS) COMMITTED TO MANAGE A MOBILIZATION CENTER FOR DADE, BROWARD AND MONROE COUNTIES IN MIAMI, FLORIDA. THE MISSIONS OF THE THESE TEAMS ARE RECEIVING, STORING, AND DISTRIBUTING SUPPLIES.

TYPE I TEAM (SHAW) COMMITTED IN NEW IBERIA, LOUISIANA. THE MISSION OF THE TEAM IS TO WORK WITH STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE DAMAGE CAUSED BY HURRICANE ANDREW. THIS INCLUDES ASSESSING, PLANNING AND COORDINATING THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF STORM DEBRIS.

FIRE WEATHER - WESTERN U.S.

A MOIST AND UNSTABLE WEATHER SYSTEM WITH SCATTERED MOSTLY WET THUNDERSTORMS IS MOVING EASTWARD OVER THE ROCKIES FROM WYOMING TO NORTHERN NEW MEXICO. ISOLATED THUNDERSHOWERS ARE EXPECTED MOSTLY OVER THE MOUNTAINS THIS AFTERNOON IN NORTHERN NEVADA, UTAH, AND SOUTHEAST IDAHO. A SECOND WEATHER SYSTEM JUST OFFSHORE FROM OREGON AND NORTHERN CALIFORNIA WILL PROVIDE SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSHOWERS FOR SOUTHERN OREGON, NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AND THE SIERRAS. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL BE IN THE 60'S AND 70'S ALONG THE COAST AND FROM WYOMING TO NORTHERN NEW MEXICO. ELSEWHERE 70'S AND 80'S ARE EXPECTED, EXCEPT 90^fS TO NEAR 100 LOWER SOUTHWEST DESERTS.

FIRE ACTIVITY: 249 FIRES FOR 3,595 ACRES REPORTED IN THE PAST 24 HOURS.

ANALYSIS: INITIAL ATTACK ACTIVITY ACCELERATED IN CALIFORNIA AND THE GREAT BASIN AREAS DURING THE PAST FEW DAYS DUE TO HEAVY LIGHTNING ACTIVITY. HIGH TO EXTREME FIRE INDICES CONTINUE TO BE REPORTED ON SEVERAL UNITS IN THE NORTHWEST, GREAT BASIN, CALIFORNIA, AND THE NORTHERN ROCKIES. REASSIGNMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEMOBILIZATION CONTINUING.

PROGNOSIS: POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR HOLDOVER FIRES FROM LIGHTNING OVER THE PAST FEW DAYS. NO MAJOR FIRE PROBLEMS ANTICIPATED DUE TO FORECASTED WEATHER. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES EXPECTED.

FIRE WEATHER - WESTERN U.S.

ISOLATED MAINLY WET THUNDERSTORMS AFTERNOON AND EVENING HOURS OVER SOUTHERN OREGON, SOUTHERN IDAHO, AND WESTERN WYOMING. SCATTERED MAINLY WET AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS IN NORTHERN AND CENTRAL NEVADA, NORTHERN AND CENTRAL CALIFORNIA, UTAH AND NEW MEXICO. WINDS 15-25 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 35 MPH ARE EXPECTED OVER THE WESTERN DESERTS AND MOUNTAIN PASSES OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA. WINDS GUSTING UP TO 30 MPH CAN BE EXPECTED OVER THE EAST SLOPES OF THE MONTANA ROCKIES. MINIMUM HUMIDITIES OF 10-20 PERCENT OVER THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AND ARIZONA DESERT AREAS. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL BE IN THE 60'S AND 70'S ALONG THE COAST, 90'S TO 105 LOWER SOUTHWEST DESERTS AND 70'S AND 80'S ELSEWHERE

FIRE ACTIVITY: 104 FIRES FOR 2,702 ACRES REPORTED IN THE PAST 24 HOURS.

ANALYSIS: CONTAINMENT TARGETS CONTINUE TO BE MET ON MAJOR FIRES. HIGH TO EXTREME FIRE INDICES CONTINUE TO BE REPORTED ON SEVERAL UNITS IN THE NORTHWEST, GREAT BASIN, CALIFORNIA, AND THE NORTHERN ROCKIES. RESOURCE REASSIGNMENT AND DEMOBILIZATION CONTINUING.

PROGNOSIS: EXPECT MODERATE FIRE ACTIVITY TO CONTINUE WITH FORECASTED WEATHER. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES ANTICIPATED.

*** RED FLAG WATCH FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA THIS
AFTERNOON FOR INCREASING SOUTHWESTERLY WINDS ***

AN UPPER LEVEL LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM OFF THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COAST WILL MOVE EAST ACROSS NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AND NORTHERN NEVADA. THIS WILL BRING SCATTERED MOUNTAIN SHOWERS AND THUNDERSHOWERS FROM NORTHEAST OREGON, CENTRAL IDAHO AND SOUTHWEST MONTANA; SOUTH TO THE CENTRAL CALIFORNIA SIERRAS, NEVADA AND UTAH. HIGH PRESSURE OVER THE DESERT SOUTHWEST WILL CONTINUE TO BRING DRY AND STABLE CONDITIONS WITH INCREASING SOUTHWESTERLY WINDS IN NORTHERN ARIZONA IN ADVANCE OF THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM. HIGH PRESSURE OVER THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST WILL GIVE WAY TO A PACIFIC COLD FRONT WHICH WILL MOVE INTO NORTHEAST WASHINGTON WITH INCREASING CLOUDS AND SHOWERS. DRY EASTERN WASHINGTON INTO NORTHERN MONTANA.

FIRE ACTIVITY: 119 FIRES FOR 307 ACRES REPORTED IN THE PAST 24 HOURS.

ANALYSIS: LIGHTNING ACTIVITY IN SOUTHERN OREGON HAS GENERATED INCREASED INITIAL ATTACK ACTIVITY. HIGH TO EXTREME FIRE DANGERS CONTINUE TO BE REPORTED ON SEVERAL UNITS IN THE NORTHWEST, GREAT BASIN, CALIFORNIA, AND THE NORTHERN ROCKIES. REASSIGNMENT OF RESOURCES AND MOBILIZATION TO THE DUNNIGAN FIRE OCCURRING AS WELL AS CONTINUED DEMOBILIZATION FROM CONTAINED PROJECT FIRES.

PROGNOSIS: POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR INCREASED ACTIVITY IN SOUTHERN OREGON WITH ON GOING LIGHTNING ACTIVITY. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES EXPECTED.
