Current Situation: One large fire was reported by the Division of Natural Resources in the state of Washington near Seattle. No other information is available. No significant activity occurred elsewhere.

Outlook - A low pressure system and associated cold front will move across Alabama on Friday and Florida on Saturday. Cool, high pressure will settle over the area Sunday, into the middle of next week. Temperatures will be 50 to low 60's in Alabama with 60's and 70's in Florida. Fire activity is expected to remain low.

**FRIDAY JANUARY 13, 1995 - 1000 MST**  
**NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I**

**Current Situation:** The State of New Mexico had a 3,000 acre fire, no other information was received. The Southern Area continues to experience light initial attack activity. In California, local units are conducting flood assessment and mitigation activities on agency lands.

**Outlook -** Arizona and New Mexico will be partly cloudy with highs in the 40's in the mountains and upper 70's in the lower deserts. Southern California will be partly cloudy with highs in the 50's. The Pineapple Express is pumping significant amounts of subtropical moisture into northern California, Oregon and Idaho. The Southern Area will have rain spreading east across the area through the weekend. Highs will be in the 40's and 50's in the mountains with 70's along the coast. No significant activity is expected.

Current Situation: The Southern Area continues to experience initial attack activity. No other significant activity was reported.

Outlook - Low pressure will slowly move eastward across the Southern Area over the weekend. Rain and a few thunderstorms will accompany the low which will move east of the Carolinas' Monday. Rains of 1/2 to 2 inches locally will accompany the system. A drier and cooler pattern will develop next week with temperatures 5-10 degrees below normal. Light initial attack activity is anticipated.
