

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, MAY 9, 1996 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** THE TEN STANDARD FIRE ORDERS ARE FIRM ***
 *** WE DON'T BREAK THEM; WE DON'T BEND THEM ***

CURRENT SITUATION: All units in the Southwest Area reported high to extreme fire indices. Burn bans are in effect in Arizona and New Mexico, with some areas closed due to fire danger. Initial attack activity continued in the Eastern Area, mainly in Minnesota. Resource mobilization through NICC was minimal.

Southwest Area Large Fires:

HONDO, Carson NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Loving) is assigned. Crews constructed line on the southern and eastern perimeters. Engines and crews continued mop-up and patrol on the western perimeter, while helicopters worked hot spots on the northern portion. The latest report is that 32 residences were destroyed, with 3 badly damaged. The value of the structures lost was estimated to be \$1.6 million.
