

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, OCTOBER 7, 1996 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** ALL FIREFIGHTERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO A SAFE ASSIGNMENT ***

CURRENT SITUATION: Increased large fire activity occurred in the Eastern Great Basin. California reported increased initial attack activity. NICC received requests for an airtanker, leadplane, 2 type I and 2 type II helicopters, a caterer, shower, radio system, 9 crews and miscellaneous overhead.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

TIP TOP, Shoshone District, BLM. A Type II Incident Management Team (Martin) is assigned. Strong winds late yesterday afternoon caused the fire to jump containment lines. Twelve to fifteen residences are immediately threatened with a subdivision with seventy-five homes within a half mile.

SPILLWAY, Wasatch-Cache NF. This fire is burning about 8 miles east of Ogden, UT. Threats are to homes within 500 feet east of the fire. Steep terrain, thick brush and dry fuels are hampering control efforts.

FAYETTE BURN, Bridger-Teton NF. No information available.
