

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
Monday, October 28, 1996 - 0530 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** THE TEN STANDARD FIRE ORDERS ARE FIRM ***
*** WE DON'T BREAK THEM; WE DON'T BEND THEM ***

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal initial attack developed in Southern California. Weather conditions remain favorable as winds continue to diminish. Resource mobilization through NICC has been minimal. Demobilization of out-of-area crews is scheduled to begin today.

Southern California Large Fires:

SUR, Los Padres NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Giachino) is assigned. The fire is being held within the existing perimeter. Limited fire activity was observed yesterday. Heavy helicopter bucket use aided suppression in steep and inaccessible terrain within the Ventana Wilderness. Crew demobilization is in progress.

WATERMAN #3, San Bernardino NF. The fire is located 1 mile north of San Bernardino, CA. A threat to structures still exists and residents on the north end of San Bernardino have been evacuated. Highway 18 has been reopened.

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR SANTA ANA WINDS THIS MORNING IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA COASTAL MOUNTAINS AND VALLEYS BELOW MOUNTAIN PASSES

An upper level low pressure area will continue to spin over the southwestern United States today. Surface pressure gradients will relax during the day, decreasing winds in southern California. Rain, snow and windy conditions will continue in the higher mountains of Arizona and New

Mexico. High temperatures will be unseasonably cool with highs from the 30's to 50's in the mountains and in the 60's and 70's elsewhere.
