*** SAFETY COMES FIRST ON EVERY FIRE, EVERY TIME ***

CURRENT SITUATION: Light initial attack activity was reported nationally. Heavy resource demobilization from California is continuing.

Southern California Large Fires:

SUR, Los Padres NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Giachino) is assigned. The fire received three inches of rain yesterday. Full containment may be declared after aerial and ground reconnaissance is completed. Heavy demobilization of resources is continuing.

OUTLOOK:

A strong upper level low over west central California will bring cold conditions with rain and snow showers to Southern California and Northern Arizona. Gusty winds of 15 to 35 MPH are expected. The snow level in Southern California will be near 5000 feet and between 6-7000 feet in Arizona. High temperatures will range from the upper 30's and 40's in the mountains to the 50's and 60's along the coast. Temperatures in the low deserts will be in the mid-70's.

Thursday, October 31st will be the last daily Incident Management Situation Report unless significant activity occurs. Weekly reports will be produced every Friday at 1000 MST beginning November 1st.
