

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1997 - 0900 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Several States in the Southern Area reported increased fire activity. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere.

OUTLOOK:

Northern and central California will be warmer and drier as high pressure begins to build across the state. Southern California will be partly cloudy, windy and cooler with a few morning showers over the mountains. Temperatures will be in the 40's and 50's in the mountains, 60's and 70's in the valleys, and 70's to mid 80's in the southern deserts. There will be northwest winds of 20-40 mph in the southern deserts.

Western Louisiana will have a chance of showers. Eastern Louisiana, Mississippi, Kentucky and northern Florida will be partly cloudy and warm. High temperatures will be in the 80's.
