

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The Southern Area has been tasked by FEMA to provide personnel to assist with emergency operations incurred from Hurricane Georges. They have assigned their Type I Incident Management Team and have placed orders to the National Interagency Coordination Center for two Type I Incident Management Teams, two Type I crews, equipment, supplies and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Wisconsin, California, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Nevada, Idaho, Montana, Washington and Oregon.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR BREEZY SOUTHWEST WINDS OF 20-35 MPH.

The western U.S. will be cool with breezy southwest to northwest winds in the Great Basin, California and northern Arizona. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms with the possibility of a dusting of snow is forecast in the higher mountains of northeast Nevada, eastern Oregon, northern Utah, south and central Idaho, Wyoming and southern Montana. There will be an accumulation of snow in the Uinta and Wasatch ranges of Utah. High temperatures will be in the 40's to 50's across the Rockies, 70's to lower 80's in the lower Great Basin and California valleys and 80's to 90's in the deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be partly cloudy with a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 90's.
