

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Texas.

SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS:

HURRICANE GEORGES: Birch's Type I Incident Management Team is operating a Receiving and Distribution Center at Roosevelt Roads Naval Base in Puerto Rico. The Team continues to support FEMA efforts on the island.

Wand's Type I Incident Management Team is operating a Receiving and Distribution Center in Montgomery, AL. The center is preparing an air shipment of 3,000 cots to be sent to Puerto Rico. The Team and miscellaneous overhead will demobilize today.

OUTLOOK:

The West will be cool and drier with milder weather along the coast. Winds will be northeast to northwest at 15-30 MPH. Montana and Wyoming will have scattered valley rain and mountain snow showers. High temperatures in the West will range from the 40's to 50's in the Northern Rockies, 70's in California valleys and lower Great Basin, and 80's to lower 90's in the deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be partly cloudy, cooler and breezy with a chance of showers and thunderstorms. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 10-20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the upper 70's to 80's.
