

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 TUESDAY, OCTOBER 27, 1998 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack fire activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for equipment and miscellaneous overhead. High fire dangers were reported in California, Oregon, New Hampshire, Mississippi and North Carolina.

NORTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRE:

NORTH FORK, Malheur NF. This fire is approximately 35 miles southeast of John Day. Wet lines, debris removal and high relative humidity are assisting in containing this fire. Fire behavior is creeping and smoldering.
