

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2000 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack activity was reported in the Eastern Area and light activity in the Southern Area. A State of Oklahoma firefighter received first and second degree burns on approximately 40 percent of his body, on a fire near Wilberton, OK. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Oklahoma, Nebraska, Kansas, Texas, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Colorado.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

PRIVATE, Texas State Forest Service. This fire, located 80 miles north of Houston, TX, is burning in a pine plantation. No new information was received.

OUTLOOK:

*** A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED FOR THE PANHANDLE AND NORTHEAST FLORIDA FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY. ***

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR NORTHEAST FLORIDA, MISSISSIPPI, AND EASTERN KENTUCKY FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY. ***

Southern California will have slightly warmer and drier conditions as high pressure aloft slowly builds over the area. It will be sunny with high temperatures ranging from the 50's to 60's in the mountains, to the 80's in the warmest deserts. Minimum relative humidity will be from 20 to 30

percent in the southern deserts and 35 to 45 percent elsewhere. Variable winds will be 5 to 15 mph.

In the South, high pressure will remain strong over much of the area with sunny conditions and warm daytime temperatures. Maximum temperatures should be in the mid 80's except in North Carolina, where temperatures will be 5 to 10 degrees cooler.

In the Northeast, high pressure will continue, with sunny skies forecast and temperatures in the 60's and 70's.
