

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

The Southern Area reported three new large fires. Initial attack activity is moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere. Very high to extreme

fire danger was reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Colorado, and Kentucky. A cold front that is stretched from the Carolinas to northern Florida will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms to the Southern Area. An upper level ridge will build into the Southwest bringing warmer temperatures and lighter winds.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CARLTON 01, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is burning near Northport, FL.

PARK, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is burning in Okeechobee County, FL. No new information received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

PIT, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is near Homestead, FL. No new information received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

SCOUT CAMP, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is burning in Osceola County, FL. No new information was received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

HORIZON, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Highlands County, FL. No new information received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

LITTLE CAESAR, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is near Homestead, FL. Highway 1 has been closed.

HILOCHEE, Florida Division of Forestry. No other information was received.

SNOW DROP, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is located in Sarasota County, FL. No new information was received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

COUNTY LINE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is burning in a dry lake bed. Air resources are being utilized in containment efforts.

RANGER STADIUM, Florida Division of Forestry. No new information was

received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

GOATS BLUFF, Oklahoma Division of Forestry. This fire is seven miles northeast of Tahlequah, OK. No other information was received.

SIMMONS, Arkansas Forestry Commission. The fire is near Fox, AR. No other information was received.

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OUTLOOK:

As a trough that moved through the Southwest over the weekend pushes east into the Mississippi Valley, an upper level ridge will build over the Southwest states bringing warmer temperatures and less wind. High temperatures will range from the 60's in the mountains to the mid 90's in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will be in the single digits in the deserts to around 20 percent in the mountains. Winds will be typical diurnal valley and slope variety with southeast winds at 10 to 20 mph on the ridges as the high pressure builds.

An approaching cold front will bring showers and thunderstorms to the Southern Area. High temperatures will be mostly in the 60's behind the front and in the 70's and 80's ahead of the front. Minimum relative humidity will be near 50 percent throughout much of the southeast except west of the front where relative humidity will range from 30 to 45 percent. Winds will be west to north at 10 to 15 mph behind the front and southeast to southwest around 10 mph ahead of it.
