

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SUNDAY, APRIL 29, 2001 - 0930 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

New large fires were reported in the Eastern and Southern Areas. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Eastern and Southern Areas and light elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire danger was reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Minnesota, and Wisconsin. The upper Midwest will experience dry conditions as an upper level ridge settles over the area. Florida will also remain dry with low relative humidity, except for the southern part of the state where showers are likely to occur. Eastern New Mexico has a slight chance of isolated thunderstorms and the rest of the Southwest will remain dry.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

FRANKLIN CREEK, Mississippi Sandhill Crane National Wildlife Refuge. This fire is near Moss Point, MS. No new information was received.

OLD MAN, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is located in Lake County, FL.

OUTLOOK:

*** RED FLAG WARNING IN KENTUCKY, CENTRAL AND NORTHERN FLORIDA FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY. ****

A dry ridge will build over central and northern Florida, with a moist flow over southern Florida. Minimum relative humidity will be near 30 percent. High temperatures will be in the 70's, with an east wind at 10 to 15 mph.

An upper level trough from the west will bring a dry southwest wind over the Midwest causing the relative humidity to drop to 20 percent. The skies will be partly cloudy with high temperatures from 75 to 85, except for near the lakes where the high temperature will be in the 60's. A south wind is forecasted at 20 to 25 mph, with gusts to 35.

The Southwest has a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms predicted in eastern New Mexico. Warmer, drier air will move into Arizona and southern New Mexico. High temperatures will range from the 60's and 70's in the mountains, upper 70's and 80's for the rest of the area, and in the 90's in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 25 percent in the mountains to 10 percent in the deserts. The wind will be from the southwest at 10 to 20 mph.
