Trigo, Cibola NF. IMT 1 (Whitney). Eleven miles east of Belen, NM. Hardwood litter. Crown fire with torching and running. Communities of Torreon and Tajique threatened and evacuations in effect for both communities.

X Fire, Kaibab NF. Three miles southeast of Tusayan, AZ. Ponderosa pine, sage brush and grass. Isolated interior tree torching.

South Tularosa, Mescalero Agency, BIA. IMT 1 (VanBruggen). Four miles southeast of Mescalero, NM. Mixed conifer. Running and crown fire. Multiple residences and outbuilding threatened.

Texas Winter Fires 2008, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). IMT managing the Huckabee, Cathedral, Las Cuatas and Mestena fires. IMT is supporting numerous fires throughout western Texas. Acres reported are a cumulative total.

Huckabee, Texas Forest Service. Thirty miles southwest of Fort Stockton, TX. Grass and brush. Rapid rates of spread and medium range spotting. Numerous structures, petroleum facilities, wind farm and a winery threatened.

Cathedral, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land 10 miles northwest of Marathon, TX. Grass and brush. No fire activity.

Las Cuatas, Texas Forest Service. Forty-nine miles north of McAllen, TX. Grass and brush. No fire activity.

Willow Pond, Florida DOF. Three miles east of Hernando, FL. Short marshy grass. Minimal interior burning. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Mestena, Texas Forest Service. Forty-seven miles northwest of McAllen, TX. Grass and brush. Minimal fire activity.

Ogle Hollow, Great Smoky Mountains NP. Ten miles southeast of Maryville, TN. Hardwood litter. No new information.

Sunrise, National Forests in North Carolina. Fifteen miles northwest of Morgantown, NC. Hardwood litter. No new information.
